

The Bob Clarke Challenge – 2024/25

SAMA has again included the Bob Clarke Challenge series of races in its 2024/25 Summer Program. The event will cater for sprinters as well as middle distance & distance runners of all ages, both male & female, competing together in two handicapped rounds (200m & 1000m) with qualification for a 500m, handicapped, final.

The two rounds and handicapped final of The Challenge will be run over three Wednesday evenings during the months of October and November 2024. Entrants will need to register up to 72 hours before each round to allow for handicaps to be calculated and for the track to be marked on the day of competition.

Athletes will be handicapped on a set sliding scale (based on age & gender) with possible, discretionary, additional handicapping based on an assessment of comparative skill levels.

Athletes need to compete in at least one of the two qualifying rounds, ie. 200m (handicapped) or the 1000m (handicapped) to qualify to run in the final. Points will be allocated, on a sliding scale, to all runners in each heat. The top 12 (added) point scorers at the completion of the two heats will qualify for the 500m (handicapped) final.

Prizes will be awarded to the top 2 point scorers at the completion of the 200m and 1000m heats.

Gift vouchers will be awarded to the three placegetters in the final as follows: -

Round 1. 200m

Run Wednesday, 23 October 2024 as per the SAMA Summer Program (A2 Handicap).

Athletes entered in this round will run in individual lanes and be catered for in the required number of races. It is anticipated that there will be two to three races with up to nine runners in each race.

Round 2. 1000m

Run Wednesday, 6 November 2024 as per the SAMA Summer Program (C2 Handicap).

This round will not be run in lanes, with all runners to start as per final handicaps and marked in lane one (1).
